Criteria

Achievement standards targeted for BSSS Modern Languages courses 2020-2024 come under the following two fields: understanding and communicating.

The listening assessment task focuses on the first of these domains: **understanding**. This task will assess your **understanding and analytical skills**. You will need to demonstrate your understanding of what you hear and provide a coherent analytical response to stimulus texts. Marking will not be based on grammar or spelling, provided that the expression is understandable for a native speaker of the target language. However, you will receive some advice about your written expression that may be useful to you for the writing tests.

Assessment task structure

The audio/video texts in the assessment task will be about the themes listed below. You will need to respond to questions about several audio/video texts. No notes will be allowed. However, if there are expressions outside of those you might reasonably be expected to know, these will be explained in the test paper.

Preparation

Theme

The theme for the program for this semester is **The Individual**. You will reply to questions about texts that treat the subjects coming from the program for the first weeks of the semester:
