

# **Description: Assessment Task 1 - Listening**

Assessment task mode: Test conditions French 2021-S1, The Individual 10 March 2021 (Week 6)

# Criteria

Achievement standards targeted for the BSSS Modern Languages courses from 2020 come under the following two fields: understanding and communicating.

For the listening assessment task, the first of these domains is our focus. This assessment task focuses on **understanding and analysis**, which will be equally weighted in the marking scheme. It is about demonstrating your understanding of what you hear; and providing your commentary coherently. Marking will not be based on grammar or spelling, provided the expression is understandable for a native speaker of the target language. However, you will receive some advice about your written expression that may be useful to you for the writing tests.

#### The structure of the test

For the audio/video clips in the assessment task, there will be a selection of subjects taken from those listed below. You will need to respond to questions about several audio/video documents. No notes will be allowed. However, if there are expressions outside of those you might reasonably be expected to know, these will be explained in the test paper.

## Preparation

You should review the resources used during the lessons over the first five weeks of the semester. For each week, in the weekly modules, you have a summary of the information and activities that form part of the program. See <u>https://languages.org.au/</u> and Google Classroom.

## Theme

The theme for the program for this semester is **The Individual**. You will reply to questions about documents that treat the subjects coming from the program for the first weeks of the semester.

- People and relationships (Les relations entre les gens).
