Criteria

Achievement standards targeted for the BSSS Modern Languages courses come under the following two fields: understanding and communicating.

For this assessment task, the second of these domains is our focus. This assessment task focuses on mastery of and engagement with the topic and associated domain(s). It is about demonstrating your understanding of your topic; and providing your commentary coherently. The marking scheme will be related to the assessment rubric, with a total of 30 marks allocated for this assessment task.

The structure of the assessment task

This assessment task will comprise a set of questions that will provide you the opportunity to show your mastery of and engagement with the topic you have selected. Aim to use language elements and structures that have been learned or encountered in our program of learning. Translation apps may not be used.

Suggested time for the discussion is 10 to 15 minutes (Advanced).
