Criteria

Your score for this assessment task will reflect levels of achievement listed in the writing assessment rubric.

Structure of the assessment task

There will be at least two options, which will relate to the subjects covered during the second half of the semester (Q4). See the list below. You will choose one of the options; but you should review several topics ahead of the test. Suggested word length for your response is 250-300 words for Continuing Tamil.

Theme

The theme of the program for Semester 2 is **Society and Community**. This assessment task will be based on topics covered in the fourth half-semester (Q4):

- Individuality of Tamil language (Domain 4 and 5)
- Contribution of Tamil in other languages (Domain 4).
